III European Tour 2015

From June 11-14, 2015 the German Chapter organized the “European Tour”, which was attended by no less than 31 teams !

For the British and Dutch teams a pre-tour from Hoek van Holland to Luxemburg via the Nürburgring- Formula 1 racing track had been arranged on June 10-11. On a strenuous route that participants could had to exercise their reading and driving skills.

Johannes Zilkens and his formidable team welcomed us on June 11 at Chateau d’Urspeilt- a magnificent location, which was our ‘home-base’ for the rally.

Following a short sleep- which had largely been caused by reading the road book- 11 cars/ teams from Germany, 11 cars/teams from England, 8 cars/teams from the Netherlands and one team from Italy made their way to the Eifel area in Germany.

Luxemburg authorities felt it opportune to increase the degree of difficulty by breaking up the road the day before. Nevertheless, all teams somehow found themselves back in the Mountains of the Eifel.

The uphill and down dale through hundreds of curves put specific pressure on the skills of the (co)drivers and the quality of the vintage cars. The accompanying service car has not been there in vain.

The participants were highly honored by the invitation of a well known brewery in Bitburg. Thirsty throats absorbed such a high quantity of beer, that the production and delivery to other consumers came under pressure.

Johannes Zilkens and his team deserve our deep and pronounced thankfulness for the organization, arrangement and guidance of the Tour. Bearing in mind that this was the first rally organized by this young member of ACHAFR ,we can only express our well meant respect and gratefulness .
