At the invitation of the Chairman of RRAF UK & Ireland, this year's Europe Tour took place from June 6-8 in Yorkshire. Under the challenging heading of "Flat Cap, Whippet & Ferret Tour" we gained a great impression of ancient towns and villages, the coastal towns and rolling countryside at the heart of Yorkshire Dales National Park.

Starting from the Aldwark Manor Hotel, North Yorkshire Pete Wilson and David Spencer surpassed the missing support of the weather gods and sent us in a never ending optimistic attitude on track – see pictures on this website- and welcomed us joyfully at the bar of the hotel in the late afternoon or even earlier , when rain and flooding circumstances induced some of us to enter shortcuts.

The 48 cars/teams from the UK, Netherlands and Germany mastered Moors, visited Harewood House and Bolton Abbey and found their way to Kilnsey Park & Trout Farm before driving through or turning away from growing brooks. At the perfectly arranged dinners the adventures of the day were exchanged and the joint experience contributed to lively discussions at the various tables.

The participants and the Board express sincere thanks to RRAF for the hospitality and to Pete, David and their team for the splendid work in preparing and organizing this year's Tour.

After last year's successful Europe Tour starting from Brescia with also 48 cars/teams from the Netherlands (16) the UK (14), Germany (9), Italy (6) France (2), even from Sweden our Fellowship underlines in practice the idioms of Rotary: cooperation and communication across borders in growing companionableness.

On the occasion of the Europe Tour we held the Annual General Meeting of ACHAFR on June 7,2017, which was attended by 33 representatives.

Specific attention has been raised to national chapters in Germany and Italy. In Germany a restart is necessary and constructive measures within a timescale is being developed.

The Board expresses thankfulness for the confidence and regards this as a task to fulfil in the forthcoming period.

-in The Netherlands from 8-10 June 2018
-in 2019 in Germany on the occasion of the Rotary International World Convention
-in 2020 in Italy as the Coast-to-Coast Tour
-in 2021 in the UK

In 2018 our International Fellowship will celebrate its 30 years . We attach specific attention to this magnificent achievement during the Europe Tour in the Netherlands and we ask
