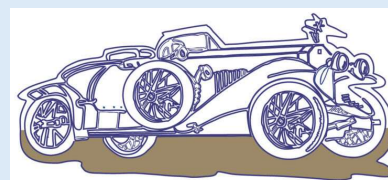

Dorint Hotel right next to the race track

- 55 double rooms at the Dorint Hotel, right next to the Grand Prix circuit
- The hotel features a wellness area, the stylish Cockpit Bar and the Fascination restaurant
- 4-star hotel with a Booking.com rating of 8.8 out of 9
- Parking for our classic cars in the historic paddock dating from 1926, right next to the hotel
- Parking facilities also available for trailers
- The entrance and exit are guarded



21 June 2027: Arrival and welcome evening

- Arrival day: Monday, 21 June 27
- Check-in from 15:00
- Parking in the historic paddock, right next to the Dorint Hotel
- From 18:00: Meet at the Cockpit Bar for the handover of rally documents and welcome drinks
- From 20:00: Group dinner at the Pistenklause, an Italian restaurant that has hosted many famous racing drivers
- Address: Kirchweg 4, Nürburg (1 km/15 mins' walk from the hotel)



22 June 27: Haus der Geschichte Bonn / ADAC Driver Safety Centre (138 km)

- Tour at Manthey Racing, a racing team with victories in the 24-hour races at the Nürburgring and Le Mans, based in Meuspath (or another racing team)
- Drive along scenic back roads to the Haus der Geschichte in Bonn, including guided tours
- It is a museum dedicated to German contemporary history since 1945. With 850,000 visitors a year, it is one of the most visited museums in Germany.
- Lunch near the museum
- Return journey via scenic back roads through the Eifel
- From 17:00, meet at the ADAC Driver Safety Centre at the Nürburgring for practical exercises, a consistency test and dinner

23 June 27: Koblenz/Nürburgring Nordschleife (142 km)

- We'll drive along scenic back roads to Koblenz on the Rhine
- Park the classic cars in front of St Castor's Basilica, followed by a tour and an organ recital
- Take the cable car from the Deutsches Eck across the Rhine to Ehrenbreitstein Fortress, followed by guided tours
- Lunch at the Blumenhof restaurant next to the basilica
- Return journey to the Nürburgring via scenic back roads through the Eifel
- From 17:00: Tour of the Nürburgring Race Control Centre
- From 19:00: 2 laps of the Nordschleife in steady-speed mode for each participant
- From 20:00: Dinner/barbecue buffet in the historic paddock

The Green Hell since 1926



- The Nordschleife opened in 1926 and is now 20.8 km long, with 73 bends and gradients of up to 18 per cent (Hohe Acht) and downhills of up to 11 per cent (Fuchsröhre).
- It is the longest permanent race track in the world.
- Each participant completes two laps with a regularity test
- Prize-giving ceremony on Farewell Evening



24 June 27: Moselle/Zylinderhaus Bernkastel (181 km)

- We drive along the Moselle, one of the most beautiful rivers in Germany, past the vineyards to the Zylinderhaus in Bernkastel
- The museum displays more than 100 cars and around 100 motorbikes. There is also a petrol station, a chemist's and other shops from that era
- Lunch at the Zylinderhaus restaurant
- Return journey via scenic back roads through the hills and numerous hairpin bends to the hotel
- ACHAFR General Meeting and presentation of the European Tour 2028
- Farewell dinner/awards ceremony for the competitions at the Dorint Hotel (dress code: black tie, evening gown)
- Trophies for the top three places, the oldest vehicle and the longest journey
